- _____ **John J. Irvine Scholarship** – Must have financial need and a GPA of 2.5 or higher.
- _____ **William Johnson Scholarship** – Enrolling in a full time program of study toward a vocational technical career, have community involvement and financial need. Provide a letter of recommendation from a vocational technical educator.
- _____ **Dorothy and Alex B. Knox Scholarships (more than one)** – Must be planning to attend a technical college or a university.
- _____ **Dr. Russell F Lewis Scholar Athlete Scholarship** – One female and one male athlete who are superior students.
- _____ **Verna Lueck Scholarship** – Must be in top 25% and intend to become an elementary education student.
- _____ **Dr. George MacKinnon Scholarship** – Must be involved in extracurricular activities, average/above average GPA and attending a college, university or technical school
- _____ **John & Marjorie O'Reilly Scholarship** –Preference to students attending UW-Marshfield full-time, financial need.
- _____ **Kaye Scheuer Memorial Scholarship** – Planning to enroll full-time at an accredited institution, 3.0 GPA, financial need, and has earned a letter in a varsity sport and have the recommendation of a head coach.
- _____ **Paul and JoAnn Schreiner Scholarship** – Must be attending a school in the University of Wisconsin system and have financial need.
- _____ **Kim Shupe Memorial Scholarship** – Planning to attend a technical college or a university and have financial need.
- _____ **Swanson Memorial Scholarships (5)** – Must be going into the field of education.

3. Describe your plans and hopes for your future, including why you have chosen the major that you indicated above. Your answer should not exceed one-half page single-spaced.

- Your senior picture (or another similar size picture, if you don't have a senior picture)
- Your name and page number should be on each page of your application.
