- \_\_\_\_\_ **William Bushman Memorial Scholarship**– Enrolling full time at a 2 or 4 year institution, a friend to all, active in the community.
- \_\_\_\_\_ **Felhofer Family Nursing Scholarship** – Planning to attend a university, technical school or special school to pursue nursing. Minimum 3.0 GPA and have financial need.
- \_\_\_\_\_ **Marilyn Hardacre Scholarship** – Must have participated in Youth Apprenticeship, CO-OP, or work-based learning and be planning to attend a technical college or a university. \*Provide a letter of recommendation from the supervising teacher or employer.
- \_\_\_\_\_ **John J. Irvine Scholarship** – Must have financial need and a GPA of 2.5 or higher.
- \_\_\_\_\_ **William Johnson Scholarship** – Enrolling in a full-time program of study toward a vocational technical career, or entering the medical field, have community involvement and financial need. \*Provide a letter of recommendation from a vocational technical educator.
- \_\_\_\_\_ **Dorothy and Alex B. Knox Scholarships (more than one)** – Must be planning to attend a technical college or a university.
- \_\_\_\_\_ **Dr. Russell F Lewis Scholar Athlete Scholarship** – One female and one male athlete who are superior students.
- \_\_\_\_\_ **Verna Lueck Scholarship** – Must be in top 25% and intend to become an elementary education student.
- \_\_\_\_\_ **Paul and JoAnn Schreiner Scholarship** – Must be attending a school in the University of Wisconsin system and have financial need.
- \_\_\_\_\_ **Kim Shupe Memorial Scholarship** – Planning to attend a technical college or a university and have financial need.
- \_\_\_\_\_ **David & Waleen Storm Scholarship** – Must be in the top 25%, attending a UW school, pursuing a degree in the medical field and have financial need.
- \_\_\_\_\_ **Swanson Memorial Scholarships (5)** – Must be going into the field of education.
- \_\_\_\_\_ **Jerry Witt Scholarship** – Must be majoring in natural sciences (chemistry, biology, physics, geology or astronomy), going to a public college, have good grades and have financial need. Should have taken higher level math, chemistry and physics.

- \_\_\_\_\_ **Masonic Foundation Scholarship** – Must be pursuing a baccalaureate or associate degree and have demonstrated leadership ability and service to school, community, and/or church.

Without it, you will not be considered for any scholarship that requires financial need.**
3. Describe your plans and hopes for your future, including why you have chosen the major that you indicated above. Your answer should not exceed one-half page single-spaced.

- Application Page
- Answer to question #1 (one page only)
- Answers to questions #2 and #3 (both included together on one page only)
- A copy of the first page of your parent's federal tax form - Only needed if you are applying for scholarships that consider financial need (Please feel free to blot out social security numbers, we do not need them.)
- Two letters of recommendation (*no more than two please*)
- Your senior picture (or another similar size picture, if you don't have a senior picture)
- Your name and page number should be on each page of your application.
- Note: By submitting this application, you and your parents are giving permission to the selection committee to review your GPA, class rank and disciplinary reports.
